**Planned infrastructure, connectivity and greenery makes Mulund special**

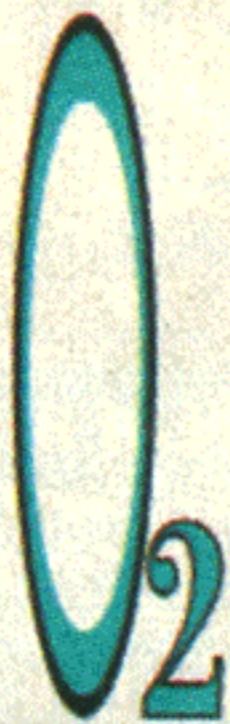
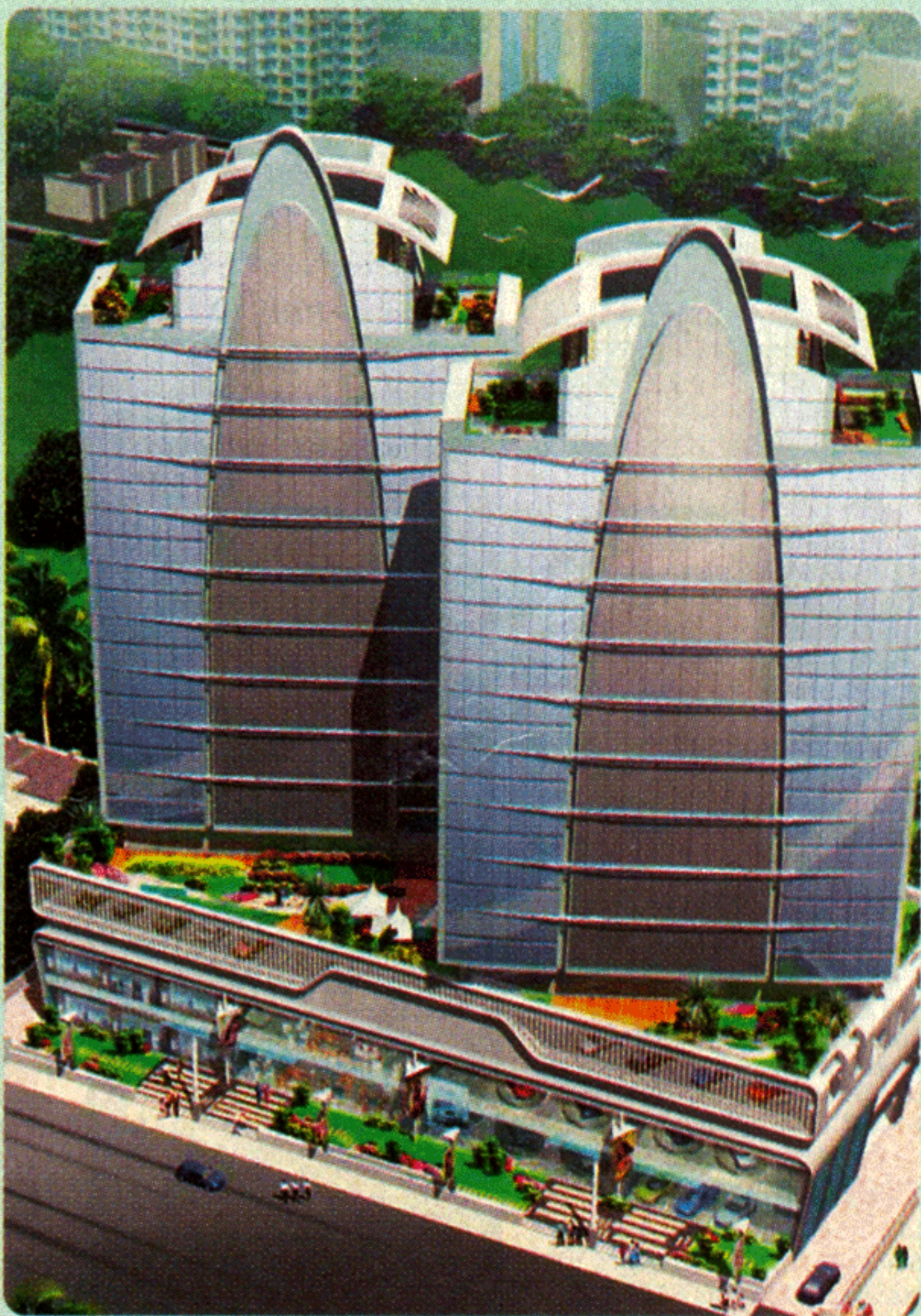
